The Canada Mosaic Mural project was launched in 2015 to celebrate our 150 birthday, beginning the journey to complete 150 murals illustrating Canada's cultural and geographical diversity. The purpose of the project is to create a national mural including all provinces and territories, 100,000's of paintings and 150 individual murals that when united will form one gigantic mural mosaic. Each province and territory will have individual communities who will elect to champion a mural production. This project will be ending July 1, 2018 so this is Fairview's **LAST CHANCE** to participate and create our **OWN** community mural, which will then connect to the nation. Upon the completion of the entire Canada Mosaic Mural each community mural will reside in the town or city where it was created as a legacy of your community and its connection to the communities across Canada.
