



FIRE ADVISORY

The Fire Restriction has been downgraded to a Fire Advisory effective October 6, 2021.

Effective October 6, 2021, the Municipal District of Fairview No. 136 has a FIRE ADVISORY ORDER in place.

In response to cooler temperatures and recent precipitation throughout the municipality, A FIRE ADVISORY has been put in place to encourage caution in order to protect fire suppression service availability of volunteer firefighting crews and AB WildFire Resources during the COVID-19 pandemic.

Although open fires are now permitted, caution should always be used with any kind of burning.

Not Allowed

- Unattended or unsafe campfires

Allowed with Caution!

- Safe wood campfires
- Backyard fire pits
- Fireworks
- Burning barrel use is permitted at a minimum distance of 30m away from structures and 3m away from combustible materials
- Charcoal Briquettes in approved briquette BBQ receptacles
- Portable Propane fire pits
- Gas or propane stoves and barbeques
- Catalytic or infrared style heaters
- Wood fires in an enclosed facility or device, which has a chimney with a spark arrestor

Allowed with Municipal Notification Requirements and a Fire Suppression Plan

- Controlled burns of large piles of agricultural brush

All producers planning a controlled burn of large brush piles, unharvested crops, or stubble, must notify the municipal office at 780-835-4903, during regular business hours only, for further directions prior to any burning. **DO NOT NOTIFY THE FIRE DEPARTMENT.**

THIS FIRE ADVISORY WILL REMAIN IN PLACE UNTIL FURTHER NOTICE AND WILL BE REGULARLY REVIEWED AND UPGRADED TO A FIRE RESTRICTION OR BAN IF NECESSARY, DEPENDENT ON VOLUNTEER FIREFIGHTING CREW and AB WILDFIRE CREW AVAILABILITY AND WEATHER CONDITIONS.
