I. When is election day?

The next municipal election will be held on Monday, October 18, 2021.

II. Where can I find information regarding the nomination and election process?

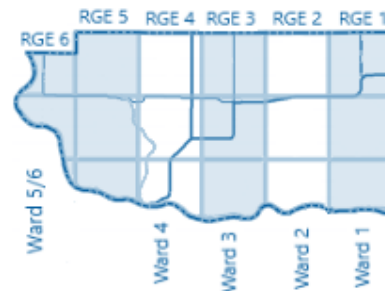
The General Information and Nomination Package provides information regarding candidate eligibility, the nomination process, campaigning and all required forms.

III. How do I know what ward I live in?

The Municipality is divided into 5 wards. You must reside in the ward for which you are seeking election.



IV. When is nomination day?

An eligible candidate's nomination package must be submitted to the Municipality's returning officer between January 1, 2021 and 12:00 p.m. on September 20, 2021. Late nomination submissions will not be accepted.

V. What must be included in a nomination package?

An eligible candidate's nomination package must include a complete Form 5—Nomination Paper and Candidate's Acceptance (with the signatures of 5 electors eligible to vote) and Form 5—Candidate Information.
