- a) the Equipment Contractor is engaged in litigation or arbitration with the Municipality; or
- b) the Equipment Contract has an outstanding debt (including, but not limited to: tax levies, utility levies, community aggregate levies accounts receivable) owed to the Municipality."

Revise 3.2 as follows:

- Remove "Timeliness" as an evaluation criteria
- Weight "Previous quantity and quality of work performed for the Municipality" as 30

Insert section 3.3:

"3.3 Equipment Contractors who have not previously performed work for the Municipality and who are registering for the first time shall receive full weighting for previous quantity and quality of work performed for the Municipality."
