

SERVICE AREA VISITS

The Municipal District of Fairview No. 136 can advise that Proponents will be able to access the Service Area at the following dates and times:

- Wednesday, April 16th, 2025 between 9:00 a.m. and 4:00 p.m. local time; and/or
- Thursday, April 17th, 2025 between 9:00 a.m. and 4:00 p.m. local time.

Access to the Service Area is permitted by ATV/UTV or by foot only; access to the Service Area by pickup (or other motor vehicle) is prohibited. Three (3) accesses to the Service Area will be made available during the above-noted dates and times. All accesses are located on Range Road 25 north of Township Road 822, in the Municipal District of Fairview No. 136. On the map attached hereto as Schedule "A", such accesses are identified in yellow.

A municipal employee will be at the Service Area to guide and direct Proponents to the access locations. The Municipality will not be providing guided tours of the Service Area, and the municipal employee will solely be on-site to facilitate access and provide a check-in contact to Proponents. All Proponents will be expected to sign-in (and sign-out) with said municipal employee and show identification. Cellular devices are mandatory and Proponents are expected to provide contact information for the same to the municipal employee at sign-in. Service Area Visits shall be self-guided, and on municipally designated routes.

Proponents shall, while visiting the Service Area:

- Bring all supplies, materials and equipment they require to perform the investigations and inspections they deem necessary.
- Ensure that they maintain insurance that a prudent Proponent in similar circumstance would maintain for the purposes carrying out the necessary investigations and inspections at the Service Area;
- Comply with any municipal, provincial or federal legislation, regulations or codes now in force or enacted hereafter;
- Comply with the provisions of the Occupational Health and Safety Act, Regulations and Code.

The Service Area visit is not mandatory; it is optional, and it is at the own risk of the Proponent. A Service Area visit is considered related to the RFP process within the meaning of Section 5.7 of the RFP. As such, by visiting the Service Area, the Proponents are agreeing:

- to hold harmless the Municipality, its elected officials, officers, employees, agents or advisors and all of their respective successors and assigns, from all claims, liability and costs related to all aspects of the RFP process; and,
- that the Municipality will not be responsible for any costs, expenses, losses, damages or liability incurred by the Proponent as a result of, or arising out of, preparing, submitting, or disseminating a Proposal, or for any presentations or interviews related to the Proposal, or due to the Municipality's acceptance or non-acceptance of a Proposal.

Proponents are required to contact the RFP Contact, Lyndsey Lawrence, prior to the scheduled Service Area Visit(s) to confirm attendance and complete registration. Access will not be permitted to Proponents who have not registered.
